



## Rules for Moon Photo Competition

### Objective:

1. The Objective of this Competition is to promote astronomy and observation of our Moon through photography. This activity is jointly organised by The Astronomical Society of Singapore (TASOS) and Science Centre Singapore in support of the International Year of Astronomy 2009 (IYA2009).

### Eligibility:

2. This competition is open to all persons above 7 years of age and who are residing in Singapore.

### Period and Submission of Moon Photo Competition:

3. The Photo competition will open on 26 February 2009 and close on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2009.

### Guidelines for Moon Photo Competition:

6. Photographs submitted must be in print form and either in 8R or Super 8R format. Judging will be based on the merit of the printed photograph. In addition, for the purpose of verifying authenticity, each photograph must be accompanied by:
  - a) digital image file saved on a CD-ROM (labeled with the photographer's name, NRIC, contact number and title of images). The digital image should have a resolution of at least 6 Mega-pixels (jpg or tiff) or higher. OR
  - ) the respective negative/slide in the case of photograph taken with film camera.
7. Photographs are to be in colour and must be original and unpublished. No digital processing, manipulation or enhancement is allowed except for lighting and exposure compensation.
8. Every submitted photograph must have a completed entry form pasted behind it.
9. All photographs of the moon submitted for the competition must be taken in Singapore during the competition period from 26 February to 31 July 2009..
10. A total of 8 prizes comprising 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5 consolation prizes will be awarded for each of the 4 competition categories, i.e. Crescent Moon, Quarter Moon, Gibbous Moon and Full Moon, as shown:

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize -S\$800.00** worth of prizes  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Prize -S\$400.00** worth of prizes  
**3<sup>rd</sup> Prize -S\$250.00** worth of prizes  
**5 Consolation Prizes - S\$50.00 each**  
worth of prizes

11. Each participant may submit a maximum of 2 photographs per category.

12. All photographs submitted must show the respective Moon phase in its entirety. Close-up shots showing just a particular spot of the moon will be disqualified.

13. All photographs, CDs, slides and negatives submitted will not be returned. In addition, the organisers reserve the rights to use, distribute, modify, post, transmit and display these documents without any compensation to the photographers.

14. All entries must be submitted before the closing date on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2009.

15. The Judges' decision will be final and no correspondence will be entertained.

16. All winners will be notified via e-mail, post or telephone.

17. All winning entries shall be displayed at Science Centre Singapore after the prize presentation ceremony on Friday, 2 Oct 2009.

18. The organisers reserve the right to make any changes with regards to the competition where necessary, and such changes shall be posted on the IYA2009 Singapore Node website <http://www.astronomy2009.sg> as well as TASOS website <http://www.tasos.org.sg>

19. All costs incurred in connection with the competitor's participation in this competition shall be borne by the competitor.

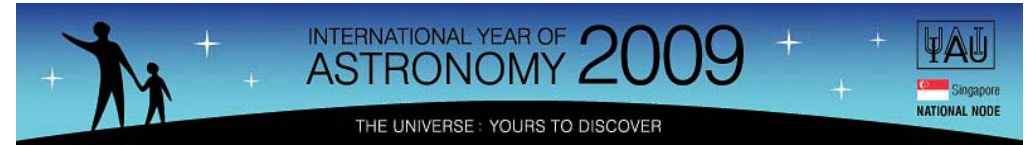
